


ability to hop on the interstate to Salt Lake only contribute to the value of this development.

Recycling Locations at Canyon Creek.

Blue Stars are paper only bins and located by the mailboxes, great for getting rid of junk mail. Green Boxes are garbage cans located by the dumpsters and are for paper products and commingled glass, metal, and plastic. You do not need to separate glass, metal, and plastic. Cardboard is a large bin by the I building, please flatten all boxes.

Canyon Creek Rules For Residents

- -Only one (1) dog or two (2) cats per condo are allowed. Immediately clean up after your pet and keep it on a leash at all times when outside.
- -Quiet hours are from 10pm-7am. Please be considerate of your neighbors.
- -Smoking is not allowed in your condo, on the balcony/patio, in the hallway or stairway or within 25 feet of the buildings. Please properly dispose of cigarette butts.
- -Parking stickers are required to park in open spaces within the community. You do not need a sticker to park in your assigned spot or in guest parking around the clubhouse.
- -Parking of trailers, recreational vehicles, commercial vehicles and inoperable vehicles is not allowed. Any vehicle not moved within 48 hours or with expired registration may be towed at owner's expense.
- -Patios are not to be used for storage. Patio furniture, gas barbeque grills, reasonable decorations and bicycles are allowed.
- -Only use HOA approved sunshades, contact the office for information.
- -Only use standard window coverings. Foil, bed sheets, or similar items are not allowed.

Reglas para los residentes de Canyon Creek

- -Sólo un (1) perro o dos (2) gatos se permiten por condominio. Limpie inmediatamente después de su mascota y mantenerla a raya en todo momento cuando esté afuera.
- -Las horas de silencio son de 10 p.m.-7 a.m. Por favor sea considerado con sus vecinos.
- -No está permitido fumar dentro su condominio, en el balcón / patio, en el pasillo o escalera, ni tampoco dentro de 25 pies de los edificios. Por favor, desechar de las colillas apropiadamente.
- -Etiquetas de estacionamiento están obligados para estacionarse en los espacios abiertos de la comunidad. Usted no necesita una etiqueta en su lugar asignado o para los estacionamientos que están alrededor de la casa club para el uso de invitados
- -No se permite remolques, vehículos recreativos, vehículos comerciales y vehículos inoperables. Cualquier vehículo que no se mueve dentro 48 horas o con matrícula vencida puede ser remolcado a expensas del propietario.
- -Patios no se pueden utilizar para el almacenamiento. Muebles de jardín, parrillas de gas, decoraciones razonables y bicicletas están permitidas. Sólo utilice sombrillas aprobados por el HOA, póngase en contacto con la oficina de información.
- -Sólo utilice cortinas aprobadas. Papel de aluminio, sabanas, o algo similar no están permitidas.
